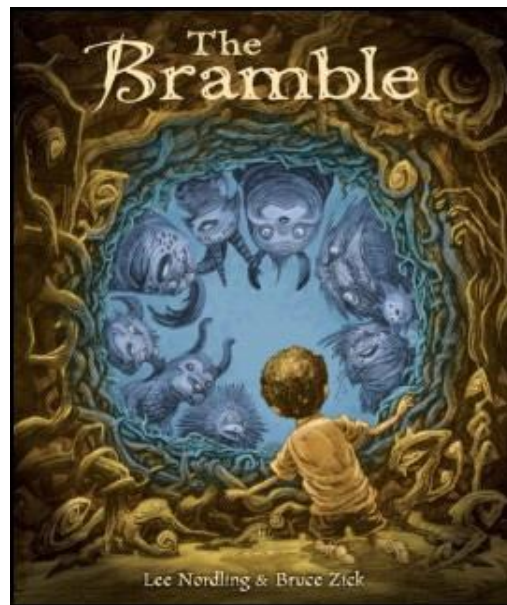

We are thrilled to announce Bruce Zick as this year's Silver Linings Luncheon keynote speaker. For more than 30 years, Bruce Zick has been designing animation features for Disney, Dreamworks, Pixar, Laika, Blue Sky, Fox, Spielberg, George Lucas, Francis Ford Copolla and many others, working on films like Hercules, Pocahontas, Tangled, Finding Nemo, W.A.L.L.-E., Inside Out, Boxtrolls, Prince of Egypt, Iron Giant and Epic. He has written screenplays for Fox Animation and his young adult novel, the Anubis Tapestry, is currently in production.



Bruce has also written and illustrated comics and graphic novels for Marvel and Dark Horse Comics and children's books for Carolrhoda Books. He worked on Thor, The Atomic Legion and Mandala and, on February 2016, his newest graphic novel, The Zone Continuum will be in bookstores. His illustrated book, The Bramble, won the 2013 Moonbeam Children's Book Award.

## Remembering Char

November 29, 1921 --

January 12, 2016

On January 12, 2016, Morrison lost a champion for our cause, Charlotte (Char) Schwartz.



Char was fiercely committed to programs that serve our communities, especially causes dedicated to youth and animal welfare.

At Morrison, she served on the board of directors from 1984 to 1990, and became one of Morrison's earliest recurring monthly donors in 1984. Char was an active supporter of our events and is a member of the Carl Morrison Legacy Society, Morrison's planned giving program.

During World War II, Char served as an air traffic controller and, later, was one of the first women in Portland to sell radio air time. She is best known for her work with Kelly Services, when she transformed a struggling Portland office into a flourishing agency.

We, here at Morrison, miss your fervent and undauntable spirit, Char. We are grateful for the time we had together and will always hold you closely in our hearts.
