Program Highlight: For the love of Fostering...

The Passes have been certified Morrison Foster Parents with Morrison's Therapeutic Foster Care Program (TFC) since 2014. The Passes initially opened their home as respite providers with our Planned & Crisis Respite Care (PCRC) Program, serving many children with significant trauma histories and mental health challenges. Respite helps support parents/caregivers and children in order to reduce hospitalization and help maintain long-term placements. In May 2015, the Passes became a TFC full-time family for three young siblings. After two years of fostering these children, the Passes used their positive experiences to encourage others in their community to adopt the three young siblings. Later, the Passes fostered another sibling set and supported their successful transition from foster care to adoption. In between full-time foster care, they continue to open their home as respite providers. It's people like the Passes whose years of dedication and reliability working in partnership with Morrison, who help us achieve our mission, goals, and objectives for the foster children served through our [Foster Care Programs](#).

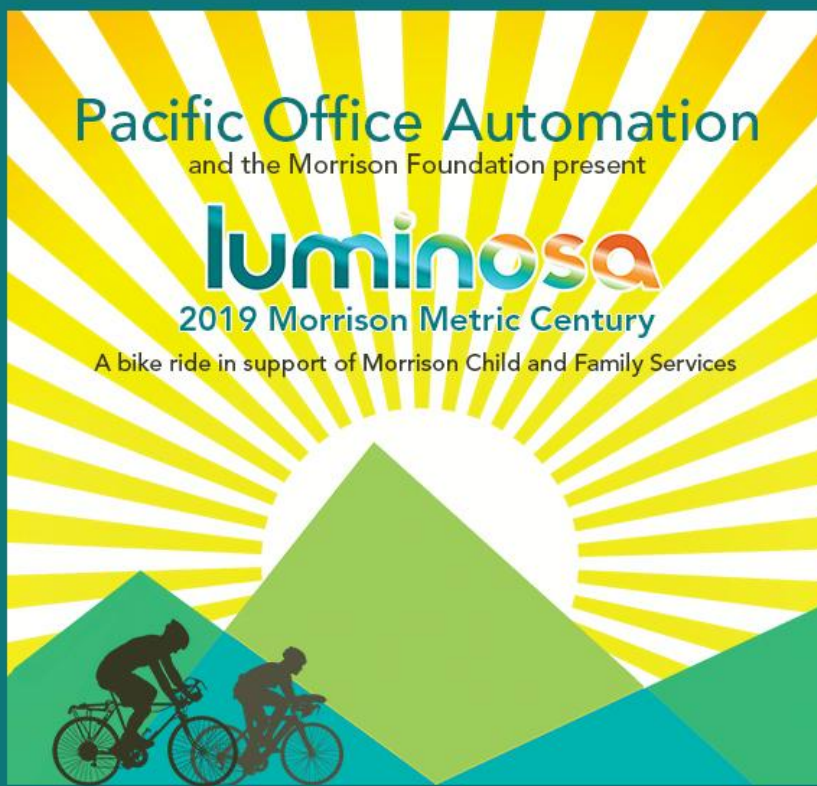
