TFC/BH-TFC/PCRC: Informed resource families effective 9/1/2021 that the use of physical restraints will no longer be allowed. Initial and annual Non-Violent Crisis Intervention (NCI) training will continue for staff and resource parents. However, the physical restraint portion of the training will not be included. Morrison TFC/BH-TFC/PCRC programs are currently implementing the Attachment, Regulation, and Competency (ARC) model to decrease the use of restraint. Programs do not use seclusion. Programs have reminded resource families to utilize Morrison On-call support phone line when behavioral concerns arise. Foster care programs prohibit seclusion.
